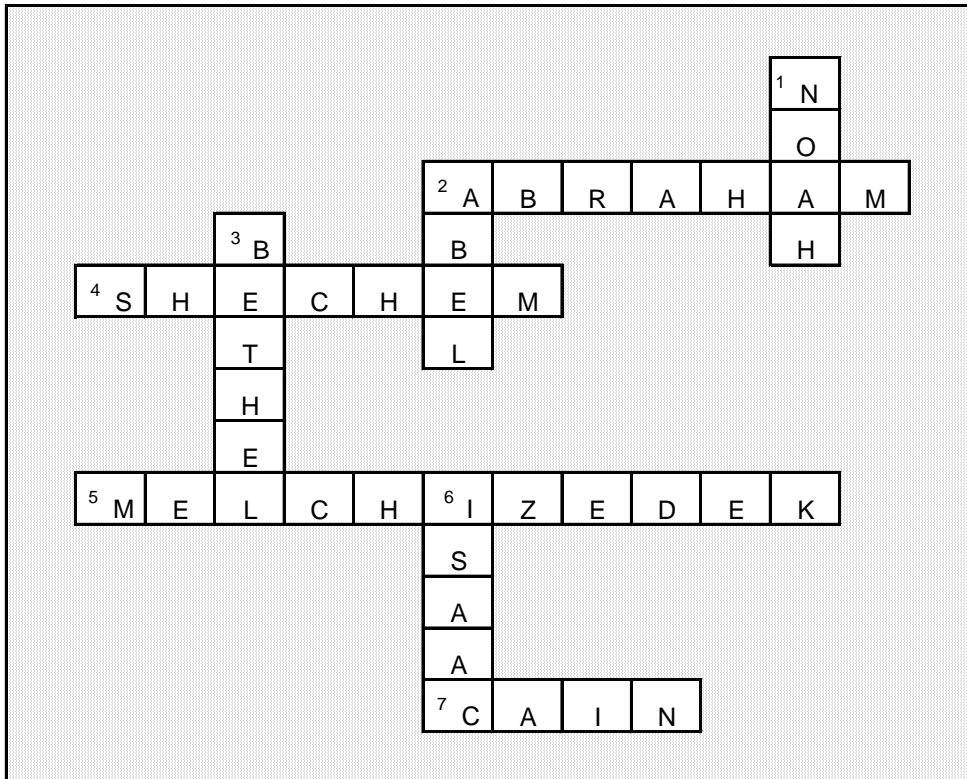


Thanks-Giving in the Book of Genesis

Down:

1. After the great flood, this man built an altar and offered animal sacrifices in thanks to God. (Gn 8:20)
2. The first offerings of gifts to God were from Cain and _____. (Gn 4: 3,4)
3. At this place, Jacob had a vision of angels going up and down a ladder. He offered a sacrifice in thanksgiving here when he returned to Canaan from Haran with his wives and flocks. (Gn 28:19 and Gn 35:1,7)
6. This man built an altar to the Lord at Beersheba when God repeated the promise made to his father Abraham. (Gn 26:23-25)
